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

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
RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE

WHEREAS, we, the Board of Trustees of the Winnsboro Independent School District, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2021 at a total tax rate of \$1.1995, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows:


\$0.9429 per \$100.00 in valuation for the purpose of maintenance and operations, and


\$ 0.9429 for the purpose of maintenance and operation, and

Such taxes are to be assessed and collected by the tax officials designated by the district.


